



Electrical Assembler

Job description– The Electrical Assembler will be responsible for assembling, wiring, and testing electrical components and systems according to detailed specifications and diagrams. The ideal candidate will have a keen eye for detail, excellent hand-eye coordination, and a strong understanding of electrical systems and assembly techniques.

Responsibilities

- Perform tasks on a variety of wires and multi-conductor cables such as cutting, sleeving, terminating, soldering, crimping, and labeling.
- Install electrical wiring and assemble components in conveyor equipment according to blueprints.
- Perform trouble-shooting tasks as required.
- Cut and route wires to various circuits.
- Use correct hand/power tools typical in the manufacturing of conveyance equipment.
- Arrange work area and strategize layout accordingly to insure an expedited assembly process.
- Testing of components and assemblies, as well as self-monitoring work to maintain quality standards.
- Work independently and within a team environment.
- Must be able to effectively communicate and follow detailed instructions.
- Confer with supervisory or engineering personnel to exchange information.
- Use of overhead crane, forklift and pallet jack.
- Follow all safety rules and maintain a clean working environment.

- Ability to stand, walk, bend, stoop, reach, push, pull and lift up to 80 lbs.
